What is Opioid Use Disorder (OUD)?

OUD is a chronic condition in which a person loses control over opioid use, including prescription painkillers, heroin or fentanyl, despite harmful consequences. It is a medical condition, not a moral failing, and effective treatment is available.

What is Stimulant Use Disorder (StUD)?

StUD involves problematic use of stimulants such as methamphetamine or cocaine, leading to significant distress or impairment. Stimulant-involved overdose deaths have risen sharply in California in recent years.

Common Warning Signs

- Increased tolerance: needing more to feel the same effect
- Withdrawal symptoms when not using
- Neglecting responsibilities or relationships
- Continued use despite knowing the harm
- Unsuccessful attempts to quit or cut down

Treatment works.

Recovery is possible for everyone.

Project period: September 2026 - August 2027



Community Outreach & Education

Workshops, wellness fairs and tabling events across Sacramento County to educate residents about OUD, StUD and local treatment options. All sessions are free.



Stigma Reduction

Campaigns led by trusted community messengers that challenge myths about addiction and shift the narrative toward compassion, dignity and public health.



Treatment Referral Navigation

We connect individuals to treatment providers, Medications for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD) and county behavioral health services, removing transportation and language barriers.



Youth & Family Education

Family-centered education and youth programming that builds awareness and prevention skills in south Sacramento County communities.



Trusted Messenger Training

We recruit and train community leaders, peers and cultural ambassadors to carry prevention messages into the settings that reach those most at risk.
